The prince was George, Prince of Wales, the son of King George the Third. The “fox” was a clever politician called Charles James Fox. Fox is remembered as a great supporter of liberty. He played a major role in the fight to end slavery in Britain, and he supported the Americans in their war of independence. This was why King George hated him. But it was not the only reason.

The king felt Fox had a bad influence on his son. Prince George spent most of his time drinking, eating, and having fun with many different women. The king used his power to force Fox out of his position in the government. However, in 1788, King George began to suffer from a serious mental illness. He was unable to act as king, so his son Prince George took over some of his responsibilities. People expected Fox to try to control the prince and hold the real power in the country, but Fox was unlucky. He was visiting Italy when the king’s illness began and then he fell ill on the way home. King George recovered his health and Fox was never able to put his plans into practice.

With such talented parents, it was no wonder that Orpheus was a talented musician. The truth was, Orpheus was more than talented. His music was magical. When he played the lyre, as his father had taught him, his songs could cast spells and comfort brutal beasts.

Orpheus loved his wife, a mortal, Eurydice. When she died, he traveled down into the Underworld. He begged his great uncle, Hades, to allow his wife to come back to Earth as herself, and not be reborn as someone else. Hades agreed, but he had one condition. Hades agreed to let Eurydice follow her husband back to Earth. But, during the trip, Orpheus had to promise not to look back until both he and his wife were safely back on earth. Orpheus was worried. He was afraid that perhaps his wife might need his help—it was a very scary trip back to the surface. He worried that perhaps Hades would not send her after all. To make himself believe that all was fine, he risked a quick look behind him, and lost his wife forever.

The moral lesson is that when Orpheus looked back at Eurydice on their way to the Underworld, he broke the condition Hades set in allowing Orpheus to bring her back. Orpheus was supposed to trust that Eurydice was behind him and must not look back to check; unfortunately, he did look back and then lost her forever. A moral lesson here is the necessity of trust, both in the gods as well as in love.

Water is in every living cell, tissue and organ, and it's second only to oxygen as the thing we need most to survive. We can't live without it, and we can't live well without enough of it. We are constantly in need of water as we lose some with every breath and every activity of the body. We are especially at risk of dehydration when we exercise or when we are ill—this is when dehydration, even mild dehydration, can **take its toll**, causing you to feel tired and drained of energy. Anyone may become dehydrated, but young children, older adults and people with chronic illnesses are particularly at risk.

If picky eating were an Olympic sport, would your child be a gold medal winner? If you think so, you're not alone. Many parents are troubled to find their children excelling at pushing food around their plate during mealtimes. How can parents turn a meal into a family-friendly hour as opposed to an all-out war? Here are some suggestions.

First, be patient. Don't force your children to eat if they refuse to finish their meal. At the same time, offer a variety of foods along with **those** you know they like. Also, parents may look for "fun" foods. Scan the supermarket for foods that you know children will enjoy. Foods with fun shapes and kid-friendly flavors are more likely to appeal to children. Lastly, parents should set an example. Children learn by example. If they see grown-ups eating a variety of foods and enjoying them, they are more likely to copy the behavior.
